By signing this Contract and Waiver and Release and by participating in the Summer Pre-Apprenticeship Scholarship Program described herein (the "Program") the Program Student and Program Student Parent or Legal Guardian agrees to accept all of the conditions for participation in the Program.

Program Students are expected to arrive at the training facility no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the class start time and expected to depart the facility no later than 10 minutes after class dismissal time. The Fund will not supervise or accept liability for Program Students prior to the 8:50am and after the 3:10pm on class days.
2. Program Students are not permitted to leave the training facility campus from arrival to dismissal time on class days. Program Students departing early will not be readmitted to class until the next class day. By signing this Contract, the parent(s)/guardian(s) authorize the Training Fund to provide a box lunch to the Program Student. Students may provide their own beverages, snacks and lunches.
3. The training facility campus rules are: no smoking, no alcohol or nonprescription drug possession and no weapons are permitted. Program Students are restricted to authorized areas. Facility instructors and administrative staff serve as campus security.
4. Program Students agree to be attentive, fully participate in class activities; and, to be respectful of training facility faculty, administrators, staff and other Program Students.
5. Program Students agree, during class time, to secure cell phones and electronic communication devices in their personal vehicles or to the custody of the class instructor and agree the Training Fund shall not be liable for any Program Student electronic device lost, misplaced or damaged phones due to the policy.
6. Program Students agree not to violate any Program or Training Facility rule, directive or instruction issued by Program or Facility personnel and may be disqualified from the program for a violation. Program Students further assume the risk of any activity in violation of any rule or directive.
7. Parents/guardians agree to provide two Emergency Contacts to the Training Fund in the event of a Program Student medical emergency. Parents/guardians authorize the Scholarship Program administrator to handle the medical emergency and then to call the appropriate emergency contact(s). Parents/guardians understand the Training Fund will not be responsible for any medical costs connected with any Program Student medical emergency.
